Upon leaving La Paz, the road first ascends to around 4,650 meters at La Cumbre Pass, before descending to 1,200 meters at the town of Coroico, transitioning quickly from cool Altiplano terrain to rainforest, as it winds through very steep hillsides and atop cliffs.

Not many people dare to try this experience, but that only makes it more desirable, right?

A luxury beach holiday destination that is set in a protected marine conservation area and offers pristine beaches and unspoiled coral reefs teeming with marine life.


